

Roxtec response to the Covid-19 outbreak

To whom it may concern,

Roxtec Inc. realizes its responsibility to our customers in Essential Critical Areas. Roxtec employees are defined as Essential Critical Manufacturing Workers as we supply products needed for national defense, telecommunication, power, petrochemical and other essential industries. Therefore, the people that work in the Tulsa, Oklahoma headquarters are regarded as essential and Roxtec Inc. would not be subject to any City of Tulsa or State of Oklahoma restrictions to our business. Our plan is to stay operational with our shipping and manufacturing departments fully staffed. We are practicing social distancing by having some of our office employees work remotely.

As of today, the majority of our global supply chain is still unaffected and all our production sites and suppliers are still operational. The interruptions we have encountered have been managed. Transportations of goods to and from Sweden will be a challenge as countries impose stricter border controls and the availability of land, air and sea freight options are reduced.

The following mitigation actions have been taken:

- Daily follow up of critical production sites and suppliers on their status and their preventive actions
- Securing raw material supply and stocks to the greatest possible extent
- Increased inventory of semi-finished and finished products
- Pre-booking of sea freights and air freights

Roxtec continues to closely follow and respond to the Covid-19 outbreak in all our markets. We thoroughly follow the advice and regulations from government and health authorities on global and national level. As a safety driven company our aim is to protect life and assets. That extends to the best interest of our staff and our customers.
